#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Discussion the proposed budget appears to be significantly higher than the 2019/2020 Fiscal Year budget. The difference between the two (2) budgets is the Sacramental Gifts line item of \$3,500. The 2019/2020 Fiscal Year budget understated our intended spending as it failed to include \$3,500 for Sacramental Gifts. By amending the 2019/2020 Fiscal Year budget to include Sacramental Gifts, the 2020/2021 Fiscal Year budget represents an overall spending increase of less than \$1,000.

- That said, due to the loss of Football concessions and the delay in starting Spring/Summer Baseball, it was acknowledged/understood when passing the budget, the Council may need to make some modifications/reductions below the amounts being budgeted for 2020/2021.
