### **GRAND KNIGHT'S REPORT:**

Start my Grand Knights report by first of all again thanking all of you for becoming Knights. And as we turn the corner into the new year we are reminded that the next five months will also be the last five months of my term as your Grand Knight. And with that fact, there will come some changes we must start gearing up the leadership that will continue at the helm of the council by appointing an elections committee soon to help to help guide us through this transition into the new officer's team. We must also encourage our current program directors and committee directors committee chairs all of whom have done outstanding work over the last 18 months to remain in their posts so that we may continue to benefit from their experience and their wise guidance. To help to make a smooth transition into our new leadership team in July, before we know it will arrive presented with a new slate of officers, then we have elections in June, and finally an officer's installation in July. In the next three months will bring our drive-thru fish fries and spring baseball concession stand business. It will take all our efforts, so I ask all of you once again to begin saving some time out of your lives for our concession stand business so that we may continue to do the charity work that is our number one mandate as Knights of Columbus. I also want to invite all who may not have served in a previous office position, to consider doing so coming in and starting in July. Start thinking about where you might fit in. Our state convention will be happening at the end of April in Corpus Christi. I believe we do send a couple of delegates from our council, so those of you who may not have ever attended a convention before please start considering becoming one. I believe we pay for all the expenses for you being there, travel so I believe that right, done in the past, so that is also accounted for. If you've never been an officer before, you might consider attending a state convention. A great time, it tends to kind of catapult you, your enthusiasm level to wanting to serve in office. I always encourage any new Knight who hasn't attended before to consider.

### FINANCIAL SECRETARY'S REPORT (Pete Perta:

Membership stands at 227. We welcome back of Jerry Jacobs transferred back to our council. Also we have a Jorge Vardage transfer out to Irving council. Membership dues collected 30% year to date. With Star council we have a membership goal of 11 we're currently in 8. Insurance they don't spot us the goal but we're at net minus 2. Budget spending year to date we spent 45.3% of our budget which calls from July 1st to June 30th so more than halfway through the budget. Forms we are current, annual survey for turn activity that was due at the end of January hasn't submitted working in the semiannual council audit which is in February 15<sup>th</sup>. Council taxes have been submitted, also completed our RSVP where we sponsored 5 seminars for \$500 each that's been mailed out to web seminarian director. Check for our annual donations to Holy Spirit for \$3500.00

# RECRUITMENT COMMITTEE (JIM KROWASKI (SP):

I'll just go through some information here and we've got right at the present a prospect of OK I don't know 15 we've got three new members that were voting on this evening, two more that are favorable. 1 that's not interested, 5 no response, 3 that we had bad phone numbers, and one that's going to join in April. We've already got 8, with the 3 we're gonna vote on, we are at quota and we've already got one to jump off with in April. So we still need to be recruiting and in the meantime if each of you will think about a way that we can encourage all of our membership to go out and recruit or ask one person between now and June the first. So we can get done with our quota, we could do triple if we really work at it. Presently the state has a contest for every person you recruit your name will go in a pot for a drawing for a travel get away. I like their contests, but I think we should come up with a better idea of a contest.

Wheelchair Sunday coming up. Prince of Peace is the largest contributor to the wheelchair in the state of Texas. The state of Texas does more for wheelchairs than the rest of the country combined! This gives you an idea how well we're doing, it's something that we should be pushing. We are trying to plan on a wheelchair Sunday coming. And by the way, the donations tell you is not affected Sunday donations, every Sunday and on he has so that's not our argument.

I also spoke this week with Paul Alley our field Agent and just like everyone else he thinks this is his best counsel and we want to keep it that way, we want our entire Diocese to know that. Does anyone here know LaDon Wright? Or knows him well? His son is an E-member, and we have not been able to reach him. If someone could go to his house, if not I will go. We have a quota of 11, we can do double/triple of our quota. There are 2 guys from our group that have done a heckuva job stand up Raymond and Robert yes absolutely that's what I've done just remember asking or give me the names and we'll contact them!

Grandknight: to make sure that Robert and Raymond are recognized for the effort that they have put out there. Contacing everybody that showed an interest in becoming a Knight, they have been on the phone with them, I'm sure making multiple calls trying to get people to come into an admissions meeting, so that they would have a brief interview, and then again we have to remind them to come in the ceremony which we are it's going to be putting on next Tuesday here in the sanctuary. Of course to make sure that we get them all the way across the finish line into that ceremony, so if there's anything that you guys need to make sure that we get we get them there please let us all talk after this meeting so make sure that we get candidates for that ceremony. We should easily have the three candidates that are interested and hopefully maybe even more.

We paid for our fish last year \$59.51 a case this year and I checked out this was as of 12:30 is \$99.50. Everything is just gone up,in terms of increasing the price we're talking like doubling it \$10 it's got \$2 right OK so alright so we're looking at probably maybe word 8 to 10 bucks. I mean it's not a deal breaker I don't think you know we used to be \$10-12.00 and I think most of the I don't know maybe Kieran can probably offer a little input while other area councils do but the check even a \$10 price tag doesn't seem extremely high for a you know a Friday evening meal but it is cooked it is I mean it is what it is it is the price that we might have to pay so rather than going I mean it's not a money making operation but we don't wanna lose money. I have to go shop around for Sunday scales for French fries.

DD- Anybody who has gone to Pappadaux over the course of the last two years you're the cost of your plate is gone up \$9 I don't think anybody is expecting our prices to remain the same everything to 2-4 dollars increase with breaking bodies sense of fairness in terms of our process we don't have the same discount ability this is what we gotta go with, and we would flex it least periods of trying to raise some money as opposed to just donate food. I would for your consideration and increase over what prior prices have been I want you to make money I want it to make sense for everybody those who are coming to those who are serving at the end of the day it's about the community coming together, even if it's going drive thru.

James Smith; No hot dogs for Super Bowl this time. Another group will provide hot dogs.

Grandknight: the price to around you know nine dollars \$10 a plate and just concentrate on fries, filets and hushpuppies and cole slaw. OK and all that's coming up at the end of February is third party match right now so I'm sorry yeah and then of course at about the same time we were considering doing a wheelchair drive and we had targeted March as a potential time for holding that but now maybe we ought to reconsider being March and fish fries at the same time what do you think we have let's let's think about that game do you think but we did tell Bill Webber that we were thinking about doing that in March so we might have to revisit that maybe push it out to April.

I think I saw it then put his hands up to I mean I will also jump in there and you know the three of us I'm sure we will we'll get this going but what's that Leonardo you know and yeah so you know I mean I think we can probably go in there and set it up we can think we can consider rolling the walls and just want a fresh white paint that's what we did last time except no last time we sprayed point in and take off everything and then we roll we roll yeah it would be faster anyway yeah gigantic well his most prized possession is the big screen TV and yes and you know and at the top of it at the wall you know it's like here you know 'cause he likes to sit way back that leaning back so he wants it just right the flooding was broken water line is that through the kitchen floor so that's what yeah so apparently that doesn't you know include doing much else I think even the war base so we'll have to we'll have to go in there and take a look at it David if you want to let's go in there and take a peek at it sometime I mean we can we can get going on this you know this weekend if you want to I see this Saturday out I won't be here Saturday but maybe the one after that or maybe even during the week or one day during the week with my consider doing OK I'll get ahold of OK wonderful OK thank you
